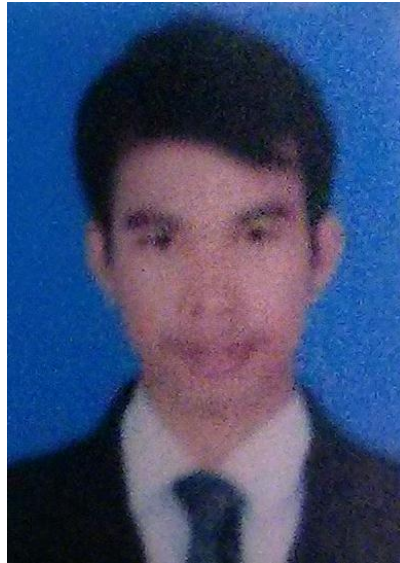


List of the dead and missing from January 3, 2014 demonstration

Kim Phaleap

February 17, 1988 – January 3, 2014



Kim Phaleap was shot at the demonstrations on Veng Sreng Road in Phnom Penh on January 3, 2014. He died in the Khmer Soviet Friendship hospital. He was 25 years old. He was from Kampong Speu province and moved to Phnom Penh in 2005 to work in the garment industry. He was employed at Ford Glory (Cambodia) Manufacturing Limited. Phaleap recently joined the union. He is survived by his wife, Khat Samneang, his three month old daughter, both parents, and six siblings.

Sam Ravy

February 18, 1988 – January 3, 2014



Sam Ravy was shot and beaten at the demonstrations on Veng Sreng Road in Phnom Penh on January 3, 2014. He died in the Khmer Soviet Friendship hospital. He was 25 years old. He was from Kampong Speu province and was ordained as a monk in his early life. Ravy worked as a garment worker at New Mingda (Cambodia) Co., Ltd. He is survived by his wife, Chhiv Phanith, his two and a half year old son, 10 months daughter, mother, and two siblings.
